Program for Year 11 2025 Subject Selection

The following timeline and information explain the procedures we have established to assist families in choosing subjects for study in senior school. I encourage you to use every opportunity we offer to seek information and guidance before final decisions are made.

1. Term 2 Week 6, Tuesday 4th June, Period 2 – MPC
Information booklets and seminar schedule issued. Launch of the "Year 11 2025 Subject Selection" google site.

This site has been developed to give access to information regarding subject selections, NESA requirements, assessment, and ATAR. It also has information about each subject offered at CGHS for senior school. We encourage parents and their daughters to watch/read this information together. 2. Term 2 Week 7, Tuesday 11th June to Monday 17th June – MPC

Beginning on this day, the school will conduct a program of subject information seminars delivered by teachers from each faculty. Each seminar will provide more detailed information than is able to be included in the subject selection booklet, as well as provide the opportunity for questions. Seminars will be held in the MPC. Student attendance is compulsory at each seminar spread across various periods in Week 7 and Monday in week 8.

3. Term 2 Week 8, Tuesday 18th June – 5:30 pm to 8:00 pm – MPC

A parent/student information evening will be held in the school MPC. Each faculty will have a display and staff members available to answer questions about subjects on offer at the school for senior years. The HT Secondary Studies and Deputy Principal will be available for general questions about the subject selection process. The Community Liaison Officer will also be available if needed for Mandarin or Cantonese interpretation.

To prevent congestion in the hallways and time to ask questions you will need to book into one of the four 30 minutes timeslots. The booking form is located on the google site listed above.

The CAPA, English and TAS faculties are also offering short presentations about each of their subjects during the evening. Please use the booking form provided on the googlesite listed above to book your seat at which ever presentation you wish to attend.

4. Day after parent/student information evening

5. Term 2 Week 9, Tuesday 25th June – MPC Parent Teacher night – 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm.

6. Term 3 Week 1, Tuesday 23rd July

OPTIONAL -Year 11 2025 subject selection interviews. Individual interview with HT Secondary Studies to discuss pattern of studies and options. Recommended if your daughter is unsure about her selection.

7. Term 3 Week 2, Monday 29th July

Subject selections must have been made on-line by this date.

8. Term 3 Week 3

Subject choices checked for NESA requirements and pattern of study.

9. During Term 3

Courses and class line structure for Year 11 2025 determined, no additional classes to be formed after this time. Students will be notified once line structure has been finalised and a confirmation email of their subjects will be sent.

Please be aware that extensions of time for students to delay committing to a subject choice are NOT possible. Therefore, it is very important to access support and information in a timely fashion. Please refer to our website for a translated version of this letter in Cantonese and Mandarin.
